**A RESOLUTION RENAMING THE  
MENTAL HEALTH / MENTAL RETARDATION PROGRAM  
TO THE  
MENTAL HEALTH / INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Dauphin is a County of the third class having its principal office at the Office of the County Commissioners, 4<sup>th</sup> floor, Dauphin County Administration Building, 2 South Second Street, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania 17101; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Dauphin is administratively organized into various departments and offices; and

**WHEREAS**, one such office is and has been known as the Mental Health / Mental Retardation Program; and


**WHEREAS**, Dauphin County desires to rename the Mental Health / Mental Retardation Program to reflect modern terminology, to recognize cultural sensitivities, and to be consistent with other Pennsylvania County governments.


**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF DAUPHIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA THAT:**

Effective May 1, 2011, the Mental Health / Mental Retardation Program shall be renamed the "Mental Health / Intellectual Disabilities Program" and all appropriate County staff are hereby directed to take whatever actions may be necessary and proper to effectuate said name change.


