

RESOLUTION # 11 - 2008

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF DAUPHIN, PENNSYLVANIA**

AND NOW, The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Dauphin makes the following Resolution for the purposes therein set forth.

WHEREAS, it is the Policy and Practice of the County of Dauphin to ordinarily prohibit the consumption and or possession of alcoholic beverages on premises which it owns, leases and or occupies; and

WHEREAS, the Dauphin County Department of Parks and Recreation, desires to host the first Inaugural Blues & Wine Festival at Fort Hunter Park, on Sunday, 31 May 2008, from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the event will feature, in addition to performing artists, eight (8) Central Pennsylvania wineries; and

WHEREAS, said wineries will be seeking to obtain and will have obtained by the date hereinabove set forth, a "special one-day permit" from the PLCB, to allow for tasting and sale of wine during the course of the Blues & Wine Festival; and


WHEREAS, the wineries have agreed to and do accept responsibility for insuring that the rules and regulations, appurtenant to the Special Permit, to be issued by the PLCB, are fully complied with.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Board of County Commissioner of the County of Dauphin, that the general County policy and practice of prohibiting the consumption and or possession of alcoholic beverages on County owned

and or leased premises, is hereby suspended, solely for Fort Hunter Park, on Sunday, May 31, 2008, between the hours of 1:00 P.M. and 9:00 P.M., for the purposes of further promoting the end of the first Inaugural Blues & Wine Festival to be held at Fort Hunter Park on 31 May 2008.






