RESOLUTION NO. 15-2006

DISASTER DECLARATION


We, the Dauphin County Board of Commissioners, do hereby declare a county-wide disaster emergency as a result of severe weather that continues to affect the Dauphin County area, beginning with significant rainfall on June 25, 26 and 27, 2006 and resulting in significant flooding around streams, creeks and rivers;

Whereas, this action is being taken in order to reduce the severity of the disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Dauphin County and surrounding areas;

Whereas, all necessary emergency management measures are being implemented to safeguard the health, safety and welfare of every citizen of Dauphin County;

Whereas, we direct the Dauphin County Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate all activities of the emergency response, take all appropriate actions needed to alleviate the effects of the disaster, aid in the restoration of essential public services, and take any other emergency response action deemed necessary;


Therefore, we, the undersigned Commissioners of Dauphin County, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 PA C.S.) as amended, do hereby declare the existence of a disaster emergency in Dauphin County, to take effect immediately.
