## REALLOCATION FOR HOME FUNDS

RESOLUTION NO. 3-2006

WHEREAS, the County of Dauphin, through the Dauphin County Housing Authority administers the HOME Program under which it provided Section 8 Lead Hazard Reduction Programs; and

WHEREAS, in administering such Program in the Fiscal Year 2003, Dauphin County provided Lead Hazard Reduction funding for participating landlords with rental standards to include one hundred and ten percent (110%) of Fair Market Rents for HOME assisted units when the statutory guidelines for such participation allowed funding only to apply to one hundred percent (100%) of Fair Market Rents; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development has determined that such funding must be repaid in the amount of Seventy Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars and Seven Cents (\$78,778.07); and

WHEREAS, such funding may be repaid from current Affordable Housing Funding in the amount of Seventy Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars and Seven Cents (\$78,778.07).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Dauphin, Pennsylvania, as follows:


1. Seventy Eight Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight Dollars and Seven Cents (\$78,778.07) in current year Affordable Housing funding is re-allocated to the HOME Program for payments disallowed for Fiscal Year 2003.




