RESOLUTION # 7-2009

Resolution of the County of Dauphin authorizing the filing of a proposal for funds with the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED), Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the County of Dauphin is desirous of obtaining funds from the DCED in the amount of \$85,000.00 for prevention and elimination of blight under Section 4(c) of the Housing and Redevelopment Assistance Law, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Dauphin County that a blighting influence exists in the area of the project being approved for because of dumping and surrounding development and the proposed project will provide for housing for individuals with dramatic mental illness by reclaiming an approximate four (4) acre tract and constructing a 15 unit affordable housing apartment building with community room and laundry facilities for adults with mental health issues.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County of Dauphin will assume the provision of the full local share of the project costs.


