RESOLUTION NO. 9 - 2008

AUTHORIZATION FOR SALE OF EXCESS PERSONAL PROPERTY ORIGINALLY PURCHASED THROUGH HUMAN SERVICES DEVELOPMENT FUNDING

WHEREAS, Section 805 of The County Code requires Dauphin County to approve a sale of excess property for value in excess of \$1,000.00 and, thereafter to advertise the property for sale in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the County, and to sell the property so advertised to the highest and best bidder; and


WHEREAS, Dauphin County has excess property for which it no longer has a use, being an Everlast Competition Ring (Property); and

WHEREAS, the said excess property was valued using a straight-line depreciation schedule, by which a value for the same is determined at \$5,206.50;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Dauphin County hereby declares the said Property to be excess property and directs that the same be advertised as required by The County Code and sold therein set forth with the proceeds of the same deposited to the Human Services Development Fund which was the source of the funds used to purchase the said Property.
