**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF DAUPHIN, PENNSYLVANIA,**

**AUTHORIZING THE REALLOCATION OF LEAD-PAINT REDUCTION PROGRAM
FUNDS TO THE HOME REHABILITATION PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Office of Community and Economic Development, in conjunction with the Housing Authority of the County of Dauphin as its Subrecipient, desires to transfer all funds previously allocated to the Lead-Paint Reduction Program to the HOME Rehabilitation Program, which provides low- and moderate-income homeowners with \$15,000.00 grants to bring their units into compliance with local and state building codes; and

WHEREAS, the County of Dauphin is aware that the Lead-Paint Reduction Program has been eliminated due to unfavorable and unwavering HUD regulations; and

WHEREAS, the County of Dauphin has implemented and completed the citizen participation process with regard to this amendment as stated in the County's approved Citizen Participation Plan and in compliance with the federal CDBG regulations; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution will serve as the amendment to the County's FY 2002, FY 2003 and FY 2004 Annual Action Plans for the transfer of funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Dauphin shall transfer \$190,000.00 of the Lead-Paint Reduction Program FY 2002 allocation, \$144,638.00 of the FY 2003 allocation and \$132,000.00 of the FY 2004 allocation for a total of \$466,638.00 to the HOME Rehabilitation Program.
