**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DAUPHIN,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF
UNPROGRAMMED FUNDS TO THE BOROUGH OF WILLIAMSTOWN
FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Williamstown desires to use funds under the Dauphin County Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program for the development of a supplemental water source which has a primary use during extended drought conditions.; and


WHEREAS, the County of Dauphin is willing to provide a portion of their CDBG Unprogrammed funds to include this activity in the County's FY 2004 CDBG Program Annual Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County of Dauphin has implemented and completed the citizen participation process with regard to this amendment as stated in the County's approved Citizen Participation Plan and in compliance with the federal CDBG regulations; and




