**INFORMATION**

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by this Information, charges that on or about January 12, 2011, at City of Harrisburg, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania, the above-named Defendant did commit the following offense:

**COUNT 1: PERJURY**  
**18 Pa. C.S. §4902(a) – (F-3)**

The Defendant, in an official proceeding, namely testimony provided at the Thirtieth Statewide Investigating Grand Jury on January 12, 2011, made a false statement or statements under oath or equivalent affirmation, or swore or affirmed the truth of any statement previously made, when the statement or statements were material and said Defendant did not believe them to be true.

The Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by this Information, further charges that on or about March of 2002, in Centre County, Pennsylvania, and various other locations the above-named Defendant did commit the following offense:


**COUNT 2: PERSONS REQUIRED TO REPORT SUSPECTED CHILD ABUSE**  
**23 Pa. C.S. §6319 – (SUMMARY)**

The Defendant, a person who, in the course of employment, occupation or practice of a profession, did have reasonable cause to suspect, on the basis of medical, professional or other training and experience, that a child under the care, supervision, or guidance or training of the Defendant or of an agency, institution, organization or other entity with which the Defendant is affiliated has been the victim of child abuse, and that Defendant failed to report or cause a report to be made in accordance with 23 Pa. C.S. § 6313.

ALL OF WHICH is against the Act of Assembly and the peace and dignity of the  
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
