There is very little room to grow or accommodate the additional caseload that would come with realignment.</p> <p>Due to the secluded region that this court serves, it only shares a boundary line with one other district in Dauphin County. Realignment of this district would not be easily accomplished without disrupting police services or inconveniencing those that may need to use this court. While geography is not to be used in making the final determination in justifying a courts existence, it must be taken into account here. The next closest court is almost a ½ hour away from the people that live closest to it. A majority of the population that this office serves is significantly farther away than that.</p>
