

**RULE 1302.**

**LIST OF ARBITRATORS.**

**APPOINTMENT OF BOARD.**

**COMPENSATION**

The Board of Directors of the Dauphin County Bar Association shall determine the names of those attorneys in the county who are willing to serve as arbitrators. The Board shall thereafter provide the Court with the names of thirty persons who are believed by the Board to be competent to serve as arbitrators. From the names suggested the Court shall select eighteen arbitrators to serve for one year and thereafter until their successors have been duly appointed and qualified by the Court. Insofar as possible, one week out of each month shall be designated by the Court for the hearing of arbitration cases and one panel (three attorneys) will sit for the entire week, with each arbitrator to sit for two weeks each year.

The compensation of each arbitrator shall be set by order of court.
