

NOTICE OF PROPOSED SUBSTANTIAL CHANGE

Dauphin County, Pennsylvania

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) appropriated additional Community Development Block Grant funds to carry out expedited, eligible activities under the CDBG program, referred to as CDBG-R. In order to access the \$406,027 in CDBG-R funds through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Dauphin County must submit a "Substantial Change" to Dauphin County's *Fiscal Year 2008 Annual Action Plan* by June 5, 2009. In order to be consistent with the overarching goals of the Recovery Act, Dauphin County will use CDBG-R funds for public infrastructure activities to provide basic services expediently to low and moderate income residents in order to create or retain jobs. Accordingly, the public is hereby informed of a Substantial Change that extends four current projects:

- **Replacement of Watermain Along North Market Street- Pillow Borough Authority.** Replacement of watermain along north side of market street from Hickory street to Union street. Total CDBG-R funds: \$10,000.
- **Replacement of Raw Watermain/ Reservoir –Gratz Borough.** This project will provide the replacement of 5,600 linear feet of old and severely deteriorated 4" cast iron raw water lines to the Borough. Total CDBG-R funds: \$ 150,000.
- **Highspire Roadway Rehabilitation Project Phase II – Highspire Borough.** The Borough will improve the roadway network within Highspire. Total CDBG-R funds: \$55,424
- **VOA Living Center—Volunteers of America.** VOA will construct 15 units of affordable rental housing for individuals with chronic mental illness in Harrisburg. Total CDBG-R funds: \$150,000.

A total of ten percent of the CDBG-R allocation will be used for administrative purposes.

The public is invited to comment on this proposed Substantial Changes for Fiscal Year 2008 for CDBG-R proposed funding. The Substantial Amendment will be on public display from May 27, 2009 until June 4, 2009 at the DCED office, 112 Market Street, 7th Floor, Harrisburg, PA 17108.
