Due Public Notice is hereby given that the Dauphin County Board of Elections will convene at 7 a.m. on Tuesday, May 17, 2022, in the Dauphin County Bureau of Registration and Election Office, 1251 South 28th Street, Harrisburg, PA, for the purpose of pre-canvassing the Absentee and Mail-In Ballots of the 2022 General Primary. One authorized representative of each candidate and one representative from each political party shall be permitted to remain in the room in which the absentee ballots and mail-in ballots are pre-canvassed. No person observing, attending, or participating in a pre-canvass meeting may disclose the results of any portion of any pre-canvass meeting prior to the close of the polls.

The Dauphin County Board of Elections will meet on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at 8:00 p.m. in the Dauphin County Bureau of Registration and Election Office, 1251 South 28th Street, Harrisburg, PA, for the purpose of canvassing the Absentee and Mail-In Ballots of the 2022 General Primary not included in the pre-canvass meeting and shall continue until all absentee ballots and mail-in ballots timely received have been canvassed. One authorized representative of each candidate and one representative from each political party shall be permitted to remain in the room in which the absentee ballots and mail-in ballots are canvassed.

The Dauphin County Board of Elections will publicly commence at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, May 20, 2022, in the Dauphin County Bureau of Registration and Election Office, 1251 South 28th Street, Harrisburg, PA, the official computation and canvassing of the returns cast at the May 17, 2022 General Primary and continue the same from day to day until completed.
